EUROPEAN KYOKUSHIN / SHINKYOKUSHIN KARATE CHAMPIONSHIP 2011 FOR ADULTS AND JUNIOR 15-16 of April Vilnius, LITHUANIA

The European Kyokushin Karate Championship will take place on 15-16 of April in Vilnius, Lithuania, in “Siemens Arena”.

1. Weight categories and number of participants for each country

a) European championship for adults (born in 1992 and elder):

Kumite men

Men Lightweight -70 kg
Men Middleweight 70-80 kg
Men Heavyweight 80-90 kg
Men Super Heavyweight +90 kg

Kata men

Kumite ladies

Ladies Lightweight -55 kg
Ladies Middleweight 55-65 kg
Ladies Heavyweight +65 kg

Kata ladies

b) European championship for juniors (born in 1993-1994):

Kumite men: -55 kg, 55-60 kg, 60-65 kg, 65-70 kg, 70-75, kg +75 kg

Kumite ladies: -55 kg, 55-60 kg, 60-65 kg, +65 kg

Kata men and Kata ladies

c) 2 participants per country in each category KUMITE and KATA.

Country organizer has one extra participant in each category.

2.Preliminary schedule

3. Financial conditions:

5. Conditions for participating in the Championship for fighters and coaches:

All competitors are requested to present:

- a written medical certificate (in English, Russian or Lithuanian languages) indication that he or she is physically fit and healthy and his/her insurance documents. This medical certificate must not be older than 3 months (women are requested to present written certificate of non-pregnant state);
- declaration for participation in the tournament.

The coach must wear the national team uniform.
